Pyramid Model: Leading the Way

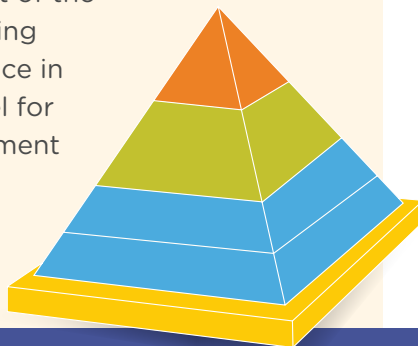


Dr. Mary Louise Hemmeter

Her work focuses on effective instruction,

supporting social-emotional development and addressing challenging behavior and coaching teachers. Through her work on the National Center on the Social Emotional Foundations for Early Learning and funded research projects, she was involved in the development of the Pyramid model for Supporting Social Emotional Competence in Young Children and a model for coaching teachers to implement effective practise known as Practice Based Coaching.
