Primary Service Provider Approach:

- Is an evidence based approach that supports parents, caregivers and teachers to gain knowledge and confidence in promoting the child's development through routine based programming.
- Positions parents as equal partners who know their child best. They are integral in prioritizing goals and objectives.
- Works alongside the families and community partners to guide and support the knowledge and skills needed to include children in all aspects of life.
- Provides one dedicated professional lead to promote child learning and development.
- Includes access to a team of professionals including a Developmental Assistant, Education Lead (teacher), Speech and Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapist and Physical Therapist.
- Uses a coaching approach to provide adults with new learning, support and guidance in the navigation of each child's development.



Key components include:

- Family centered practices
- Routine based goals are functional and routine based
- Collaborative team practices
- Coaching to adults for new learning
- Coordinated joint visits support continuous learning
