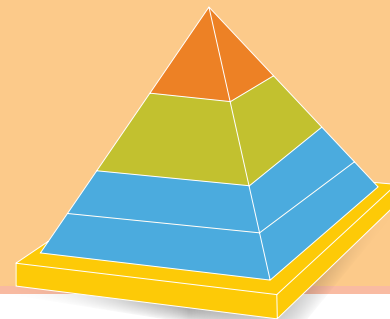

Dr. Mary Louise Hemmeter

is a professor of Special Education at Vanderbilt University. Her passion and dedication to the

early childhood field is evident in her research and publications. She has been involved in the development of the Pyramid Model for Supporting Social Emotional Competence in Young Children and a model for coaching early educators.

The Pyramid Model is a conceptual framework of evidence-based practices for promoting young children's healthy social and emotional development. Building upon a tiered model of support, the framework provides universal supports as a foundation for an inclusive learning environment, targeted social and emotional supports, and intensive supports to respond to challenging behavior. Each tier offers strategies for individualizing supports for children with diverse learning abilities.

Successful implementation of the Pyramid Model requires strong leadership and a selected evidence-informed coaching approach.
